Hibben/Miller to approve Ordinance 631 amending provisions pertaining to Speed Regulations (City Code Chapter 63), in its first reading. The Mayor and City Attorney Craig Ament explained that language was added to close loopholes in instances, for example, where there isn't a street sign in a residential neighborhood. Roll call vote: Ayes-Four. Motion carried.

Discussion: John Peverill asked if there are plans to move the army tank at Meyers Lake. Mayor Deutsch responded, no and that the tank had been there so long that it had become a landmark. Councilman Dewater stated that he believed there might be military restrictions from the Department of Defense on moving it. Peverill asked about the preservation of goose's nests along the island at Meyer's Lake during the renovations. The Mayor responded that the DNR has been involved with doing an egg and goose roundup in the past and as a result, are aware of the nests. Private funds are being used for the renovations; however the Park Board is supervising the project. Loraine Atkins stated that there are cars parked on Jones Road just north of Central Ave despite the no parking zone. The Mayor explained that the Council had re-opened a 90 feet portion of the no parking zone temporarily at the request of the owner of the apartments.


Discussion
