

CITY OF EVANSDALE STORM WATER COMMISSION

The Storm Water Commission met on May 27, 2014 at the Evansdale City Hall at 10:03 a.m. Commission Member Rick Reuter called the meeting to order. Members present: Kenny Loftus, Loraine Atkins, and Rick Reuter. Members absent: Richard Clements. Quorum present.

Commission Member Rick Reuter reported that he attended the storm water training conference for contractors in Waterloo last fall.

Reuter stated that the revenue gained from the storm water fee added to water bills approximately totaled \$26,000.00. Commission Member Loftus questioned if the revenue from the storm water fee could be used to help fix flooding issues. Mayor Faas asked if the Storm Water Commission would be in favor of recommending to Council using the funds to help repair the drainage problems on the Grand Boulevard sidewalk. Atkins/Loftus motioned to let the City Council utilize the storm water fee revenue to fix the Grand Boulevard sidewalk drainage. Ayes-Three. Motion carried.

Reuter informed the Commission that the City is working with local businesses to pave gravel parking lots to mitigate dust and dirt run-off. Commission Member Loftus recommended putting this issue on a future agenda to follow up on the businesses' progress.

There being no further discussion, Reuter/Loftus motioned to adjourn at 10:24 a.m. Ayes-Three. Motion carried
