1. Call to order: 6:00, all present.
2. Approval of the June 6, 2022 agenda: Motion by Ron, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Joe, motion carried.
3. Approval of the May 2, 2022 meeting minutes: Motion by Rick, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Joe, motion carried.
4. Approval of Bills and Authorization to pay: Motion by Joe, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Rick, motion carried.
5. Reports
  - a. Treasures Report: as submitted.
  - b. Park Maintenance: Per Chris, nothing to report. Sand Volleyball passed along their gratitude for the shed at Gardner Park.
  - c. Campground Maintenance: Nothing from Roger.
  - d. Camp Host Report: Nothing to report. Currently at \$157,000, last season's total was \$212,000. Last weekend there was only one open and available spot.
  - e. Dog Park Report: Trail construction to start soon. There will be a fundraiser in August during the Elk Run City celebration.
  - f. Disc Golf Report: Progress is behind due to the weather.
6. Discussion/possible action: July 2022 Wage increases: For fiscal year 2023. Rick Murray will increase from \$11 to \$13 per hour at 20 hours per week. Cleaning ladies will increase from \$150 to \$200 per month each. Camp Host TBD. Roger will increase from \$8,000 to \$8,500 per season. 10. Request to repair gable siding on the beach house in an amount not to exceed \$250: Motion by Rick, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Joe, motion carried.

11. Request to repair split rail fence at shower house in an amount not to exceed \$650:
