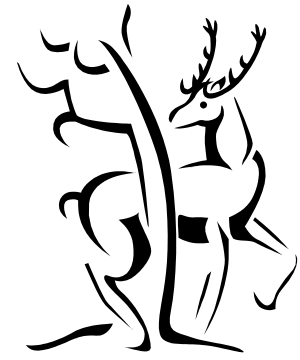


Park & Recreation Commission

1. Call to order: 6:00 all present.
2. Approval of the July 11, 2022, agenda: Motion by Rick, 2nd by Joe, motion carried.
3. Approval of the June 6, 2022, and June 23, 2022, meeting minutes: Motion by Ron, 2nd by Joe, motion carried.
4. Approval of bills and authorization to pay: Motion by Rick, 2nd by Joe, motion carried.
5. Reports
 - A. Treasurers Report: Provided in packet, no discussion.
 - B. Park Maintenance: EYSA playground fenced off.
 - C. Campground Maintenance: Roger is searching for a safe weed trimmer for campers to use on a trial basis. Looking for solutions for weeds under campers.
 - D. Camp Host report: 3 dog rule, WIFI issues, Sheryl provided Tom a list of requests / suggestions to improve camper stays: “stop” and one way traffic arrows painted on the road near stop signs, golf cart rules, curfew times for kids, speed enforcement, guest parking, two vehicles per camp site. Trailers or motor homes that should be in junk yards, Signs to show “this area is full”, an overnight pull through, map of campground with site numbers.
 - E. Dog Park Report: No update.
 - F. Disc Golf Report: Most, but not all trees are out.
6. **Discussion/action:** Refund new camp hosts camping fees paid for remainder of this camping season in the amount not to exceed \$1,018.50: Motion by Rick, 2nd by Joe, motion carried.
7. **Discussion/action:** Search for new campground software: Tom is researching, “Campground Master Software”, “Campspot”, Motion by Joe, 2nd by Rick to start search for new software, motion carried.
8. **Discussion:** Asphalt overlay Angel’s parking lot: We have a quote for \$55,000 for asphalt overlay, plus an additional \$15,500 to expand. It is currently not in the budget. Per Chris, this needs to be done sooner, rather than later, within two years. Put in to next year’s budget?

9. Discussion:
 - a) Waterways project, "Cedar Rivers clean up festival", clean up project for Cedar Falls and Waterloo ends at Evansdale.
 - b) Request for a kayak dock launch point from mouth of creek. Kayak docks are made of plastic and can be pulled as needed, in the event of flooding.
 - c) The road near the camp host is washed out. It needs two inch large rock.
