1. Call to order: 6:01, all present.
2. Approval of the November 7, 2022 agenda: Motion by Rick, with updated date, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Ron, motion carried.
3. Approval of the October 10, 2022 meeting minutes: Motion by Ron, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Dave, motion carried.
4. Approval of the bills and authorization to pay: Motion by Rick, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Ron, motion carried.
5. Reports
  - a. Park Maintenance: No updates.
  - b. Campground Maintenance: No updates.
  - c. Camp Hosts: new season high for camping fees at \$260,943.88.
  - d. Dog Park: No update.
  - e. Disc Golf: Mike said progress is slow moving, not enough volunteers. Chris has helped to make some progress. Mike is projecting a late spring to early summer opening date with new grass. All of the old baskets were sold. All sponsorships have been sold. He needs railroad ties. Chris / Roger will provide.
  - f. Campground sewer project: The project will start November 8<sup>th</sup>. Water and electrical lines are marked.

6. Ball Park updates: EYSA has removed all of their items from the facility. They took one bleacher, which is to be returned. A letter from the city attorney was provided to Danielle Peters regarding bleachers, bats, balls, tees, bases and the mobile stop sign which are city property. Rodney says they have replacements for all of the appliances. Cedar Valley has an upcoming car drive. They have a t-shirt sale in progress. December 3<sup>rd</sup> from noon to 4:00 there will be a Soup lunch / silent auction at Lofty's. The quote for insurance is in process. The maintenance committee has a list of projects to work on. The leaking water hydrant has been repaired. The D5 light on the pole with the rotten wood has been removed until it can be replaced. Chris will check the remaining poles. Chris noted there are 18 metal poles being replaced on Lafayette that could be used as light poles. Motion by Rick to donate \$900 from the Friday Night Rec fund line to Cedar Valley Youth Sports, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Ron, motion carried.
7. Discussion/possible action end of year Campground review, rules/prices: New fliers with map, rules. Rules for camp sites, bottles / cans. Golf cart rules, people walking through camp sites, curfew for kids, one trailer per pole, no cheater cords (30/50 amp), guest parking, clean camp sites, tent rates with kids, junky campers / motor homes, mowing around the campers, one way and stop arrows painted on the pavement, no checks – use “square”, review rates, dump fee increase, seasonal in full hookup only. Auto shutoff for showers estimated at up to \$3,500.
8. Discussion Budget: Bathrooms at Meyers Lake, Playground maintenance, golf cart for campground, rearrange the 5 year plan.
