1. Call to order, 6:00 PM, Rick is absent.
2. Approval of the December 05, 2022 agenda: motion to approve by Ron, seconded by Joe.
3. Approval of the November 07, 2022 meeting minutes: motion to approve by Ron, seconded by Dave.
4. Approval of Bills and Authorization to pay: motion to approve by Dave, seconded by Joe.
5. Reports
 - a. Treasures Report: Included in packet.
 - b. Disc Golf: Tees have been picked up, grading work has been done, things are moving slow. There is planning going on and trying to get volunteers for spring. Working with businesses to make tee signs and getting sponsors. Chris is helping to get railroad ties. New course is on track to open next summer.
 - c. Dog Park: Looking to hear about gaming grant soon
 - d. CVYSA: Fundraiser at Lofty's was a success. Estimated to have \$4-5K for start up right now. The can drive has brought in \$2900 with more coming. Making good progress. Sign ups will be in February this coming year to help get organized. Volunteers should get a hold of Wanda. Bleachers have been returned and quite a few appliances have been donated.
 - e. Sewer project: The project is going well. It is at the top of the hill working on individual sites, trying to get plumbing done before major snowfall this month. The first pay estimate is going to the City Council.
6. ICAP Inspection: State liability inspection, checked playgrounds. Inspector went around to the parks, asked about ordinances, specifically about firearms and prohibition. Several issues at Angel's park need correction: need to bring in more mulch to prevent divots and clearance issues. Also need to remove excess threads from bolts on some other equipment.

At Deerwood, mulch was addressed and whether or not pea gravel should be used due to effects of flooding. The swings need replaced and the "no pets" sign needs to be relocated.

7. Budget Workshop: Several items were revised and discussion about possible inclusions to the budget. The two women that clean restrooms are retiring. There was discussion of placing an ad and a possible interested party. Salary will need to be decided upon in the near future with hiring commencing by the first of April.
8. Discussion: The campground software needs to be addressed and a replacement decided on. Review is ongoing with decision after the first of the year. Campground maps and rules need updated. Looking at the option of taking mobile credit card payments.
