## PUBLIC NOTIFICATION

### **MONITORING VIOLATION OF THE WATER TESTING SCHEDULE**

Our water system violated a drinking water standard over the past year. Even though this was not an emergency, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened and what we did to correct this situation.

We, the Evansdale Water Works Public Water Supply, are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During June 2019 we did not monitor or test five (5) sample sites for coliform bacteria and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of our drinking water during that time.

#### **What should I do?**

There is nothing you need to do at this time.

#### **What happened? What is being done?**

Every month we test five (5) sample sites for coliform bacteria. We missed doing the tests in June. Testing was resumed in July 2019 and has been done every month since then. We have taken steps to insure that this does not happen again. We apologize for this oversight.
