1. Call to order: 6:00 Ron is absent.
2. Approval of the February 7, 2022 agenda: Motion by Rick, 2nd by Joe, motion carried.
3. Approval of the January 3, 2022 meeting minutes: Motion by Dave, 2nd by Joe, motion by carried.
4. Approval of Bills and Authorization to pay: Motion by Rick, 2nd by Dave, motion carried.
5. Reports
 - a. Treasures Report: provided.
 - b. Dog Park Report: Council decided not to submit to gaming. Gaming told us we had a better chance for approval if we submit in the fall. The current electric pole had been hit by lightning. MidAmerican decided to remove it. It would cost around \$15,000 to \$30,000 to replace it. Per DeAnne we can add \$15,000 to \$20,000 back into the budget. (the sewer project came in lower by \$41,000)
 - c. Deerwood Sewer upgrade project: See handout.
6. Discussion/action Disc Golf course expansion: Mike is having trouble finding a general liability insurance policy. We will check to see what the city has for general liability covering the disc golf course. Motion by Rick, 2nd by Joe to spend up to \$5,000 for the disc golf renovation, motion carried. To be paid in fiscal year ending June 30, 2022.
7. FY2023 Budget workshop: Motion to approve by Rick, 2nd by Joe, with \$900 added to Friday Night Rec, motion carried.
8. Discussion/Action: Purchase new mower for Deerwood Campground in an amount not to exceed \$9,880.85 with trade in. Motion by Joe, 2nd by Dave, to purchase the new mower outright, motion carried.
9. Discussion/Action: Seasonal contract update. Change #6 from \$8.75 to \$9.50 per day. Change #11 to remove within 24 hours or it may be removed at owner's expense. Take out storage fees.
10. Discussion/Action: Purchase of camping envelopes. Update rates on our registration envelopes. Add failure to register and pay promptly when due may result in a late fee of \$20.

11. Discussion/Action: Five Year Park Plan. Tom had an example of a stone sign for \$2,300.

12. Discussion:

- a) Speed bumps.
- b) Joe was approached by a group wanting to reserve the entire campground for a Memorial Day 2023 concert for 5,000 attendees. Table till next month.
- c) "The Dyrt" campsite review website had 2 Deerwood reviews, both positive.
