2. Approval of the March 7, 2022 agenda: Motion by Ron, 2nd by Joe, motion carried.
3. Approval of the February 7, 2022 meeting minutes: Motion by Ron, 2nd by Joe, motion carried.
4. Approval of Bills and Authorization to pay: Motion by Rick, 2nd by Joe, motion carried.
5. Reports
 - a. Treasures Report: Report provided.
 - b. Dog Park: Looking for a corporate sponsor. Will apply to gaming this fall. New bridge is in. Add a boulder or post to prevent snowmobile traffic on bridge? Table till next meeting.
 - c. Disc Golf: Sold out on sponsorships. Chris will take out marked trees as weather allows to clear areas for new fairways. City insurance covers course with the exception of tournaments. PDGA tournaments have their own insurance.
 - d. Deerwood Sewer upgrade project: Everything is a go, passed through Council, waiting for fall.
6. Setting time for sign up for seasonal campers as April 4th, 2022: Signup will be allowed starting at 4:30 at City Hall until the start of the Park Board Meeting, and continuing after. No deposit, pay in full at the time of signup.
7. Discussion/action: Rule changes – Campground: Failure to pay modified.
8. Discussion/action: Prioritizing 5-year plan: 15 items listed for potential projects. Rick will update and provide list for discussion and ranking.
9. Discussion/action: Purchase additional speed bumps for Deerwood Campground: Motion by Rick to spend up to \$600 to purchase two sets of speed bumps (budget line 6724), 2nd by Joe, motion carried.
10. Discussion/action: Purchase wood treatment for bridge at Angels Park: We are a year or two overdue retreat / water treat the decking planks on the bridge. Joe will get estimates.
11. Discussion/action: Utilizing Deerwood Park as a location for a Concert: Joe did not receive any feedback, so no deal.

- c) The MidAmerican pole for Bunger Park is \$30,000. 7 new poles were installed in Elk Run at no cost.
