**Campground Maintenance:** Joe Benhoff discussed several small projects hes working on. Also reported dump fee donations are on the decline. He suggested an updated sign be installed to help remind the users of the dump their financial responsibility.

A bench at Gardner park is bent in. City hall lawn is in need of thatching. Also performed an inspection of all the park bathrooms. Thursdays will be the scheduled mowing day.

**Angels Park:** Donna Frickson reported that there are plans to raise the statue of the 5 girls to prevent people from playing on it. Railings are ready to be installed. The perineal plants appear to be coming back this year.

**Splash Pad:** The city council has agreed to back the project.

**Camping Pads:** Patio pads will be 8'X10' and poured 4" thick. These will be located in the drive thru area.

**Seasonal worker Deerwood:** Wayne Weisbrod will be paid out of the Temp. Seasonal budget. This will retro back to May 1, 2014. He will work 20 hrs. a week.
