1. Call to order: 6:00 all present.
2. Approval of the September 12, 2022, agenda: Motion by Rick, 2nd by Ron, motion carried.
3. Approval of the August 1, 2022, meeting minutes: Motion by Ron, 2nd by Joe, motion carried.
4. Approval of the bills and authorization to pay: Motion by Rick, 2nd by Joe, motion carried.
5. Reports
 - A. Treasures Report: As submitted. Camping fees, \$241,186 YTD.
 - B. Disc Golf: New pads are not yet poured, hopefully this fall.
 - C. Dog Park: There will be a “howling Dog Park” in October. They have \$30,000 in their account and are actively working on a grant.
 - D. Park Maintenance: No updates.
 - E. Campground Maintenance: No updates.
 - F. Camp Hosts: Hole, on agenda.
 - G. Sewer Project: Work should start between October 1st and the 15th. We are getting bids for the survey work.
6. Discussion/Action – Boulders in Bunger Park in the amount of \$600: We originally approved \$400 for 2 boulders, we now need 3 boulders. There was confusion because there are two bridges with boulders needed for both sides. Motion by Rick, 2nd by Joe to add \$50 to the previos approved motion for \$400 for 3 boulders, motion carried.

7. Request to purchase 3 8-foot benches for Angels Park for \$446 each from K Park Industries: Motion by Ron, 2nd by Rick, motion carried.
8. Request to purchase a replacement seat for picnic table that was damaged at Gardner Park for \$80 from K Park Industries: Motion by Rick, 2nd by Joe, motion carried.
9. Request to pay Washland to convert two gas dryers to propane for \$125 dollars for laundry room at Deerwood Campground: Motion by Ron, 2nd by Joe, motion carried.
10. Request to have Aire Services run gas line to the laundry room for propane hookup. Not to exceed 1,185.31: Motion by Ron, 2nd by Dave, motion carried.
11. Request BH Electric to install a 60-amp breaker and feed at the Beach House to replace the one by the Fireman's Shelter not to exceed \$1,477: Motion by Joe, 2nd by Ron, motion carried.
12. Request the street crews fill in a sinkhole at Deerwood Campground. Not to exceed \$400: Motion by Ron, 2nd by Joe, motion carried.
13. Softball contract update and discussion: EYSA reported that A+ Plumbing will be replacing the urinals, Miller Fence will complete their work by the end of September, no answer yet on the lift station.
14. Discussion: Our two bathroom cleaning ladies are planning to retire.
15. Adjournment: Motion to adjourn at 7:30 by Rivk, 2nd by Joe, motion carried.
